5. Conduct citizens hearing. Public comments accepted on agenda or non-agenda items. The public is invited to address the Board of Supervisors on District related issues. Each participant wishing to speak must fill out a public comment card prior to the start of the meeting at the participant sign in sheet location and turn same into the Assistant Secretary prior to the Call to Order. Participants will be heard in the order of the cards received. The District will only accept comments on the same position of the same subject from the first three participants to submit cards. Each speaker is limited to three minutes. Each speaker is limited to one time at the microphone, regardless of how many minutes are used. The public comment period is limited to a maximum of thirty minutes. Unused minutes from one speaker cannot be yielded to another speaker. The District Supervisors may not comment, act or respond on items which are not on the agenda in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act.
